MISSION

PETER & PAUL COMMUNITY SERVICES (PPCS) PROVIDES HOUSING AND SUPPORTIVE SERVICES TO THOSE WHO ARE HOMELESS, ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO EXPERIENCE MENTAL ILLNESS OR LIVE WITH HIV/AIDS.

FY11 RESULTS

75% of residents in our clinical transitional housing programs successfully transitioned to a life of self-sufficiency and independence.

Peter & Paul Community Services...

ENDED HOMELESSNESS

for 212 men and women.

PREVENTED HOMELESSNESS

for an additional 119 people.

SERVED MORE THAN 127,000 MEALS

to those who were homeless or living on limited or fixed incomes.

PROVIDED TEMPORARY HOUSING

to 495 men in our emergency shelter.

PROGRAMS

Emergency Shelter – Provides case management, access to health care, substance abuse counseling, food and showers for approximately 500 men annually.

Meals Program – Serves up to 200 men, women, children, elderly and veterans daily who are homeless or living on limited or fixed incomes.

711 Allen Transitional Housing Program – (Substance Abuse Services) Housing and case management for men who are homeless and substance abusing.

Labre Center – (Mental Health Services) Responds to the challenge of mental illness providing transitional housing, case management, occupational therapy and nursing for men who are homeless and living with a mental illness.

Positive Directions – (HIV Services) Responds to the challenge of HIV/AIDS providing transitional housing, case management, occupational therapy and nursing for men and women who are homeless and living with HIV/AIDS.

FUTURE PROJECT:

Safe Haven – The PPCS Safe Haven will offer permanent supportive housing for men and women who are chronically homeless.

1980s

Volunteers in the Soulard neighborhood open a shelter and meals program for those who are homeless and living on fixed incomes.

Peter & Paul Community Services incorporates as a 501c3.

711 Allen Transitional Housing Program is opened for men at the emergency shelter.

1990s

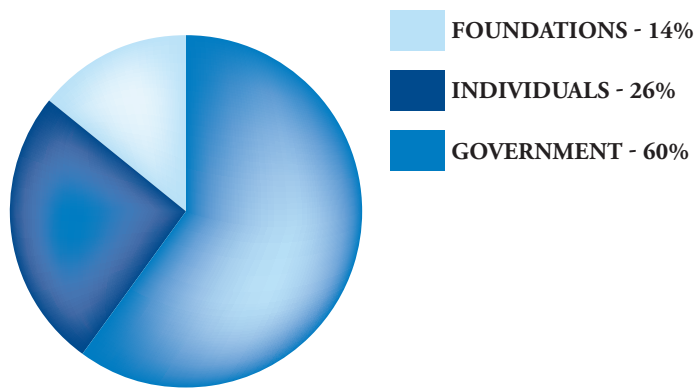
Benedict Joseph Labre Center opens in the Shaw neighborhood for homeless men with mental illness.

Positive Directions Program opens in the Dutchtown neighborhood for homeless men and women living with HIV/AIDS.

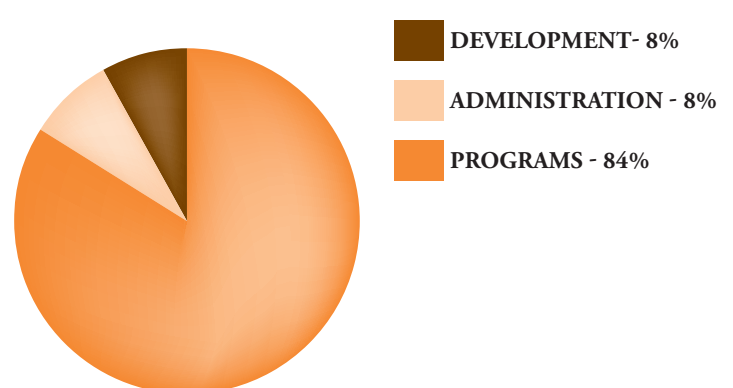
2011
