



Good Neighbor Policy

You can stay here at the Soulard Shelter free of charge. With this freedom comes the responsibility to be a good neighbor to those who live and work around us.

It is important that we be responsible and considerate members of the community in which we live. As such, your behavior in the neighborhood is very important to us. If disturbances occur in the neighborhood caused by any resident of this shelter, this could risk our shelter's closure. For this reason, the Soulard neighborhood and Peter & Paul Community Services ask that you refrain from the following:

- Panhandling of any kind anywhere in this neighborhood
- Drinking, using drugs and loitering on the streets, parks, or vacant lots in the neighborhood
- Gathering and hanging out in the neighborhood without a specific purpose
- Creating excessive noise or a loud ruckus when coming to and from the shelter
- Leaving trash in areas that are not trash receptacles. Please don't litter.

Please be respectful to all shelter residents, volunteers, and staff, as well as the neighbors you might interact with when you come and go.
